



WHAT TO EXPECT

3's to 4's:

We believe that it is our responsibility to partner with you to introduce preschoolers to their Heavenly Father. So, before they leave UpTown Preschool and move on to kids BIG city, we want them to know:

Every month we focus on one of these three basic truths. Each week your child will learn a Bible Story and participate in fun, creative activities that teach the key truth for the month. You will be given a Small Talk card when you pick up your child. You are the best teacher for your child, so use the activities on the card to talk about God all week at home. We want Sunday to be the BEST DAY of your child's week. The following information will help you understand what the Sunday morning experience is like.

What do Sunday mornings look like at UpTown Preschool?

As soon as your preschooler arrives, he or she will participate in a MAKE IT FUN activity relating to the day's Bible Story and captivating their attention.

Then, it is on to Worship and the Bible Story presentation via DVD where they are encouraged to sing, dance and interact with their leaders.

Following Worship and Bible Story, they go back to their classroom to talk about what they have learned and what it means to their young lives. They will also pray together as we teach them what it means to talk to God.

During the last part of their morning, they will participate in several creative and fun activities designed to help them better understand the key truth of the day through hands on experience.

Be sure to bring a change of clothes and label all items including cups, snacks, clothes, etc. If your child is potty training, please communicate with you're his or her teacher. Please wear pull-ups to the classroom if potty-training. Volunteers must leave the door open to the bathroom and assist with clothing (as needed).

We provide toys, activities and snacks in the classrooms. We serve goldfish and fruit loops. If your child has allergies or special dietary needs, please inform the staff and bring appropriate snacks for them.

Please do not bring extra toys. This will prevent frustration when asked to share their toy from home.

Your preschooler will be promoted to the next classroom each fall based on the school calendar.
